Organizing Committee of the Open Junior World Cup (OC)

**Date:** 04. – 08.Aug 2009

**Place:** in Nõo, Estonia

**Participants:** The Open Junior World Cup is a competition for clubs. Each member federation can send two Teams for each discipline.

Men youth	Max 10 players born 1995 and before
Women youth	Max 10 players born 1995 and before
Mixed youth	Max 10 players born 1995 and before
Men junior	Max 10 players born 1991 until 1994
Women junior	Max 10 players born 1991 until 1994
Mixed junior	Max 10 players born 1991 until 1994

The players have the right to participate if they reach the determined age during the year of the competition.

It is only possible to participate in one age category.

One player can take part in two disciplines, either in Men and Mixed or in Women and Mixed.

Each team may have maximum two players of other clubs.

Players are not allowed to play in different clubs during the tournament.

**Delegation:**

The maximum number of a delegation is as follows:

**Referees:**

Each delegation has to bring at least one referee with the IIA certificate at the OWCup disposal.

The referees must wear the official IIA-referee-polo and long black trousers.

**Competition Rules:**

According to the IIA "Official Indica Rules 2008", to the "Open Junior Worldcup in Indica - Regulations 2008" and to the "Penalty-fees-Regulation" of 10.1.2009.

Competitions in a given category only take place, if there are at least four teams of three different countries in the provisional registration.

**Entry fee:**

**For IIA member federations: Euro 100,-** per one team

**For Non-IIA member federations: Euro 200,-** per team for the first three teams and **Euro 100,-** for each additional team.

The bills will be sent to the participating federations after receiving the provisional registrations. The entry fee has to be paid until **MAY 6<sup>th</sup> 2009** at the very latest.

**Provisional registration**

This form has to be received at the IIA Secretariat by **MARCH 6<sup>th</sup> 2009** at the latest.

**Definitive registration of delegation members and clubs**

This form has to be received at the IIA Secretariat by **MAY 6<sup>th</sup> 2009** at the latest.

**Name registration of the referees**

The nominative registration of the referees has to be received at the IIA Secretariat at the same time as definitive registration, by **JULY 6<sup>th</sup> 2009** at the latest.

### **Nominative registration of the players and officials**

This form has to be received at the IIA Secretariat by **JULY 6<sup>th</sup> 2009** at the latest.

### **Accreditation**

All official members of the delegations have to be accredited by OC.

The accreditation dates are on 5<sup>th</sup> August 2009 and it will take place Nõo Competition Hall.

### **Insurance**

This is compulsory and responsibility of each participant.

During the accreditation the Head of Delegation has to confirm by its signature to Organizing Committee that all members of delegation have a medical insurance.

### **Accommodation**

Please book the rooms for your delegation as soon as possible DIRECTLY at [uno@livolon.ee](mailto:uno@livolon.ee) (Mr. Uno Ainsoo, President of OC).

### **Press centre**

OC arranges a press centre, which will be supplied with the lines of the telecommunications and with the equipments as follows: at least one telephone, one fax and one computer with internet connection.

### **Registration of the journalists**

The registration of the journalists has to be received by the IIA Secretariat at the same time as definitive registration, by **MAY 6<sup>th</sup> 2009** at the latest.
