

**3<sup>RD</sup> OPEN WORLD CUP 2010**  
**IN TARTU, ESTONIA**  
17. - 21. of August 2010

## **Information from the president of OC, Uno Ainsoo, about the current situation:**

1. The competition will take place in Tartu [www.tartu.ee](http://www.tartu.ee) , in the new sports hall of Estonian University of Life Sciences <http://sport.emu.ee>.
2. The participants will be accommodated in the hall of residence of Estonian University of Life Sciences. According to current estimations, the price of accommodation will be 20-22 EUR per person/per night. The final price will be clear as soon as the OC is notified about the number of people who wish to be accommodated. The price will not be higher than 22 EUR. The hall of residence is recently renovated. The rooms are mostly double rooms with a WC, shower and a small kitchen. The distance between the competition hall and the hall of residence is about 80m. The participants can also stay at different hotels in Tartu. Information about hotels in Tartu can be found at <http://www.visittartu.com/tartu-city-tourism-information/accommodation-in-tartu>
3. Breakfast and lunch will be served at the cafeteria of the university which is about 30m from the hall of residence and 30m from the competition hall. There will be a separate cafe at the competition hall. The dinners will take place at different cafes, restaurants etc., in order to give the competitors a chance to enjoy music and dance. The exact program of dinners will be compiled. The estimated price of breakfast is 5..6 EUR, lunch 7..8 EUR and dinner 7..8 EUR.
4. Using public transportation in Tartu is free of charge for all the participants.
5. All information about the World Cup will be posted on the EEIL website [www.indiaca.ee](http://www.indiaca.ee). EEIL will be responsible for posting the information.

7. All bookings (transportation, accommodation, catering) should be done through the OC by sending your requests to the same address. If a club wishes to organise accommodation, transportation or catering on their own, they should inform the OC.
